

CANTONMENT BOARD CLIFTON

TENDER NOTICE

Cantonment Board Clifton being procuring entity invites sealed bids for "procurement of services of Integrated Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Management on the basis of "Two Stage Two Envelope Procedure" under Rule 36(d) of PPRA Rules 2004, for a period of two years commencing from the date of execution of agreement extendable for further one year at the option of the procuring entity from the contractors / firms having minimum experience of five years in Integrated Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Management and WHICH are on Active Taxpayers List of the Federal Board of Revenue.

SCOPE OF WORK

Daily sweeping in residential areas, daily twice sweeping in commercial areas, door to door collection of garbage through compactors collection of garbage from commercial areas, institutions, market places, open plots, and all garbage points (open, cemented and iron) etc., transportation of MSW firstly to the garbage transfer station (GTS), Segregation of MSW transported at GTS, disposal of re-useable material, deduction of the price of re-useable material as per rates to be fixed by the Board, transportation and disposal of MSW at landfill site, QR code / RFID tags for bins, trackers and GPS/ RFID tags for garbage vehicles etc. The detailed scope of work has been given in the Tender document.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Tender / Bidding documents containing Invitation to the bid/Tender Notice, Instructions to bidders, Form of Bid, detailed scope of work/manpower/machinery/equipment etc, Conditions of Contract Agreement and Bid evaluation criteria etc. can be obtained on any working day during office hours from the office of Cantonment Board Clifton (CBC) CC-38, Street 10, Kh-e-Rahat, Phase-VI, DHA Karachi on or before closing date of tender bid. Price of the bidding documents is **Rs.2,000/-** (non-refundable). Tender/bidding documents can also be downloaded from CBC website www.cbc.gov.pk
2. Separate tenders / bids shall be submitted for each sector i.e. Sector No.1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Clifton Cantonment area.
3. 2% (two percent) earnest money / bid security of the annual quoted bid cost for each sector separately must be accompanied in the shape of Call deposit in the name **Cantonment Board Clifton**, from Scheduled banks in accordance with the Rule 25 of PPRA Rules, 2004 and subsequent amendments (if any). An Affidavit to the affect stating that 2% bid security /earnest money has been placed in financial proposals /bids must be attached in the technical proposals. Any bid security not validated from bank can result into penal consequences.

4. The bidder shall quote lump sum per month bid for all the works as enumerated in the tender documents. However, unit price shall be quoted as per schedule of prices in tender document to justify the lump sum monthly bill.
5. The successful bidder shall maintain his own workshop for quick repair and maintenance of vehicles, machinery, equipment etc.
6. In case the parking space for workshop and conservancy vehicles, machinery and equipment is arranged by the procuring entity, monthly rent of Rs.3,00,000/- per sector shall be paid by the successful bidder.
7. The submission of Bids by the bidders implies that they are fully conversant with the scope of work and terms and conditions laid down in the tender / bid's documents.
8. The eligible contractors / firms are required to submit their Bids for work in a single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelope shall contain separately the financial proposal and the technical proposal clearly marked as "**FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**" and "**TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion. A single package containing two separate envelopes i.e. the financial proposal and the technical proposal accompanied with bidding document fee shall be addressed & send to Cantonment Board Clifton.
9. Technical proposal must be numbered & a table of contents inserted at beginning of the proposal showing the table of contents of the proposal according to the numbered pages. All pages of Bids shall be signed & stamped by the bidder and seal be affixed along with the signatures / initials/ Stamp.
10. Contractor / Bidder blacklisted by Cantonment Board Clifton or involved in litigation or found to be indulged in corrupt or fraudulent practices will be considered non responsive by Cantonment Board Clifton being procuring entity.
11. Financial Proposal shall be retained in the custody of Cantonment Board Clifton without being opened and the technical proposal shall be discussed with the bidders with reference to the CBC's technical requirements. Those bidders willing to meet the CBC's requirements shall be allowed to revise their technical proposals following these discussions and the bidders not willing to conform their technical proposals to the revised requirements shall be allowed to withdraw their respective bids without forfeiture of their bid security.

12. After agreement with the bidders on the technical requirements, bidders who will be willing to conform to the revised technical specifications shall submit their revised technical proposals and supplementary financial proposal, according to the technical requirement. The revised technical proposal along with the original financial proposal and supplementary financial proposal shall be opened at a date, time and venue announced in advance.
13. The whole proposal shall be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria as per bidding document.
14. Only upto two decimal digits (0.00) will be considered for evaluation of the quoted Rate. If any document submitted along with bid documents found false / bogus, the registration of the contractor / firm shall stand cancelled/ blacklisted in the light of enabling provisions of PPRA Rules 2004. Conditional / Incomplete bids shall not be acceptable.
15. The bid validity period shall be ninety (90) working days after the bid is received and opened. The tenders/bids shall be opened on 14th January, 2021 at 01:00 pm. Technical Bid will be opened on the same day at 01:30 pm in the CBC main office in presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives who may choose to be present under rule 28 (2) of PPRA Rules, 2004 (As amended upto date) and financial proposal will be retained.
16. All the governments taxes (Federal, Provincial & any other) will be deducted as per prevailing government policy.
17. Incomplete/ disfiguring/ overwriting/ by hand/ delayed bids shall be declared non-responsive.
18. Any bid received in the contravention of enabling provisions of PPRA Rules, 2004 will be declared non responsive by the procuring entity. Cantonment Board Clifton being procuring entity reserves the right to accept or reject any tender/bid on technical/administrative grounds under Rule 33(l) of PPRA Rules, 2004.
19. Other terms & conditions pertaining to the works can be seen in the Office of the Cantonment Board Clifton at any working day during office hours.
