NOTIFICATION

Rawalpindi, the 13th August, 2015

S. R. O. 803 (I) /2015.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (18) of section 282 of the Cantonments Act, 1924 (II of 1924), the Cantonment Board, Clifton with previous sanction of Federal Government hereby publish following Bye-laws for regulation of erection, re-erection and sharing of temporary structures in Clifton Cantonment, Karachi, for general information, namely:—

1. **Short Title and Commencement.**—(1) These Bye-laws may be called the Temporary Structures' Bye-laws, 2015.

(2) These shall extend to the whole of Cantonment.

(3) These shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. **Definitions.**—(1) In these Bye-laws unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,

- (a) “Act” means the Cantonments Act, 1924 (II of 1924);
- (b) “antenna tower” or “mast” means a structure used to support an antenna at some height above the ground;
- (c) “BTS” means base transceiver station;
- (d) “Director” means the Regional Director Karachi, Military Lands and Cantonments Department;
- (e) “Director General” means the Director General, Military Lands and Cantonments Department;
- (f) “licence” means permit for erection or re-erection of temporary structure under these Bye-laws against payment of licence fee;
- (g) “licensee” means a person who has been granted licence for erection or re-erection of temporary structure under these Bye-laws;
- (h) “licence fee” means a fee charged against grant of licence under these Bye-laws;
- (i) “public right of way” shall have the same meaning as has been assigned to it in the Pakistan Telecommunication (Re-organization) Act, 1996 (XVII of 1996);
- (j) “schedule” means a schedule to these Bye-laws;
- (k) “telegraph” shall have the same meaning as has been assigned to it in the telegraph Act, 1885 (XIII of 1885);
- (l) “temporary structure” means an enclosure, cabin, fence, tent, awning, shed, hut, standard, stay, strut, pole, post, BTS tower, antenna tower and alike temporary structures, roofed or otherwise, whether of masonry brick, wood, mud, metal or any material, whether raised on ground or any floor or on top of a building or hanging; and
- (m) “tower” means—(i) any BTS used as an earth-based transmitting or receiving station for cellular phones, paging services and other wireless
